First: Think about this question:

Then:

* Come up with 2 or 3 ideas on what you think will make your school better.

* Write a few paragraphs from these ideas. Try to tell a story and remember to be persuasive!



* Develop some creative ways to deliver your speech to your classmates. I have a lot of ideas in my book for how you can be creative. Make sure everyone will remember you and what you have to say!

* Speeches should be between one and three minutes in length!
