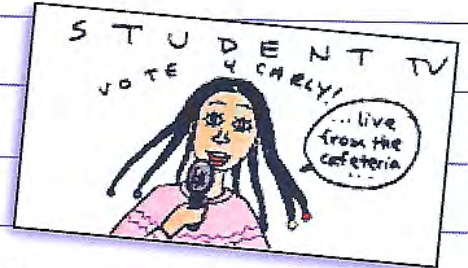


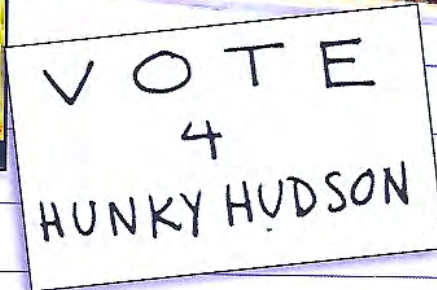
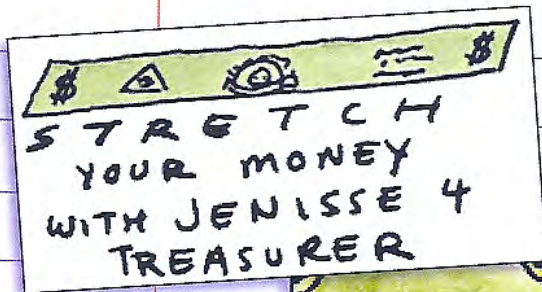
CAMPAIGN POSTER CONTEST
